What is a Content Moderator?

Content moderator jobs are on the rise because the online world, let's face it, can sometimes be a harsh and cruel world. Thus, a Content Moderator is always on guard, ensuring published material online is aligned with the reputation of an enterprise. They screen, monitor, and detect content that does not comply with the website's guidelines.

What does our Content Moderator do?

Our social media and Website content moderator serves four primary functions:

1. Every day, review and monitor new content in all of its forms (such as: articles, images, videos and audio clips) in all Watch Web channels.
2. Detect and suspend inappropriate content uploaded by users that violates the Watch's guidelines, as defined in our Group Charter.
3. Make recommendation as to the disposition of suspended content to the Lead Watch Facilitator and act upon resulting leadership direction about the final disposition of suspended content.
4. Assist Watch leadership in drafting and publishing new content.
